- Use the Career Center for **resume reviews, mock interviews,** and **job search help**
- Attend **career fairs, industry panels,** or **networking events**
- Utilize the Student Money Management Center to create a **post-graduation budget** and **manage student loans**
- Submit **job** or **graduate school applications early** in the year

SENIOR YEAR TIMELINE

- August:** Finalize post-grad plan: job, grad school, gap year
- September:** Get advised for Spring classes and do final grad check | Apply for graduation | Attend Fall job fairs
- October:** Register for Spring classes | Apply for graduation | Submit FAFSA if continuing to grad school | Finalize resume
- November:** Continue applying to grad schools or full-time jobs
- January:** Prep for interviews | Attend Spring career events
- March:** Confirm post-grad plans | Accept offers or next steps
- May:** Graduate! Reflect and celebrate accomplishments
