SOCIOLOGY MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

36 hours in Sociology, of which 24 must be advanced, including the sociology core curriculum (15 specified hours in sociology) and 18 hours of sports culture courses from the approved list below, of which 12 hours must be taken at UNT and at the advanced level (3000 or 4000).

Note: Students must receive a C or better in sociology core curriculum courses.
